


The perfect single mom side hustle and a deal!

My friend Donna and I have worked together for years in my day job as a Textile Designer

She's a CAD artist with amazing skills. Recently, she started a new venture. It's an up and coming company that's rated highly by Forbes and Bloomberg. And it's something I think would make a great side-hustle for many of you! She helps students in China learn conversational English by simply speaking to them. Besides Donna, I know two others that are successfully working at this same company and have left their regular jobs to work from home. In other words? It's well vetted.

Is this something that could work for you?

Company: [VIP Kids](#)

Hours:

Since China is essentially on the opposite schedule as the US, peak times for teaching on the east coast EST are 5am-8am (6am-9am during Daylight Savings time). Weekends are also a peak time. You are required to perform a minimum of 12-15 classes per month.

Donna typically works from 5am-8am M-F and several hours over the weekend.

Pay:

The first week, she made \$100. As she's gotten a handle on how things work, it's easier for her to schedule more hours. In her first month, still learning the system, she made \$1500 working part time. Last week, Donna made \$800 working full time on her own schedule.

Each class is 30 minutes and you are paid per class. Pay starts at \$7 per class. But, if you start on time you make an additional \$1, and if you complete 45 classes in a month, you make an additional \$1 per class.

In addition, there are other bonuses, such as recruiting other teachers, having a student sign up after doing a trial run with you, doing field trip videos, etc. They pay once per month.

Experience Needed:

Since this is a premium service for Chinese students, the company prefers teachers with at least a Bachelor's Degree. However, those with an Early Childhood Development Certificate or ESL Certificates may also be considered.

Teaching experience isn't necessary, but any teaching experience helps. If you taught Sunday school, boy scouts, youth group, or worked as a camp counselor, all of those things are taken into consideration. In my opinion, any mom has teaching skills!

Other things they look for:

They prefer teachers from North America

A warm personality that kids would relate to

Someone who interacts well with children

Someone who is willing to use props, such as toys, to help explain simple concepts to young children

How it Works:

Teachers speak with children face-to-face through [VIPKids](#) online live-stream portal. For each child, you are sent a Power Point lesson plan for the class you are going to teach. The child has done pre-work for each class, and will have follow-up work after the class. Teaching one child per class, you will follow the lesson plan. For younger children, concepts taught are more about blending sounds, learning phonics, and some simple meanings of words. For older children, content similar to public schools in the US is covered. The goal is for the child to practice English with native English speakers. While you may have some students that are regulars, parents often prefer their children to speak with a variety of teachers so that they can be exposed to a variety of different native English speakers.

The approval process takes about 10 days.

Equipment needed:

Fast internet connection (direct router connections work best)

Computer with camera or camera attached

Headset with a mute button
